Select Course allows you to choose a specific course to satisfy a requirement. **Advisor Message** communicates personalized information on a requirement. **Info** displays the course description from the current catalog. **Critical** identifies key courses necessary for timely degree completion. **Lock** sets a course to a specific term. **Remove** discards a requirement that is not needed for degree completion. Removed courses may always be restored to plan. **Notes** convey important details about a requirement. **Add Course** allows you to manually add courses not included in plan.
